..... new seeds


..... new plants

..... new life.






#### Something to think about ...

- 3. What do you think might happen if pollen from one particular type of flower settled on the sticky pistil of a completely different species of flower?










"Life" ... a precious God-given gift.



Jesus told the people this story:


A sower went out to sow his seed.


As he sowed ... some of the seed fell by the wayside and the fowls came and ate them up.

Some fell on stony ground where there was little earth, and when the sun rose they were scorched ... and because they had no root they withered away.


Some fell among the thorns ... and the thorns sprang up and choked them.

But others fell in good ground and brought forth fruit.








